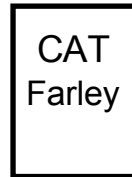


Graves with missing / stolen markers are marked in grey

After the Army left the upper reservation of Fort MacArthur, the cemetery fell into a state of neglect. During this time, many of the graves were vandalized and most had their grave markers stolen. After the museum opened in 1985, some of the markers were anonymously returned. Until such a time when the graves can be restored, the museum staff has removed the rest of the markers for safekeeping.
